A photography exhibition called “Women of a New Tribe” by Jerry Taliaferro, will start on March 9, from 10 AM to 6 PM in the “Dimitrie Gusti” National Museum of Ethnography. The exhibition opening event will be organized by the American Village Museum.

“Women of a New Tribe” is an extensive photography exhibition by the photographer Jerry Taliaferro, after a long career in the military. The exhibition contains 200 photos.

Jerry Taliaferro was born in the town of Fort Belvoir, Illinois. In high school in 1972, he joined the Army. He was posted to North Carolina for Special Forces training in 1981. While serving, his photography continued to grow and in 1985 his works were published for the first time in one of his images. In July 1988, he left the military and began his pursuit of photography. Over the years his interest turned more to fine art photography.
